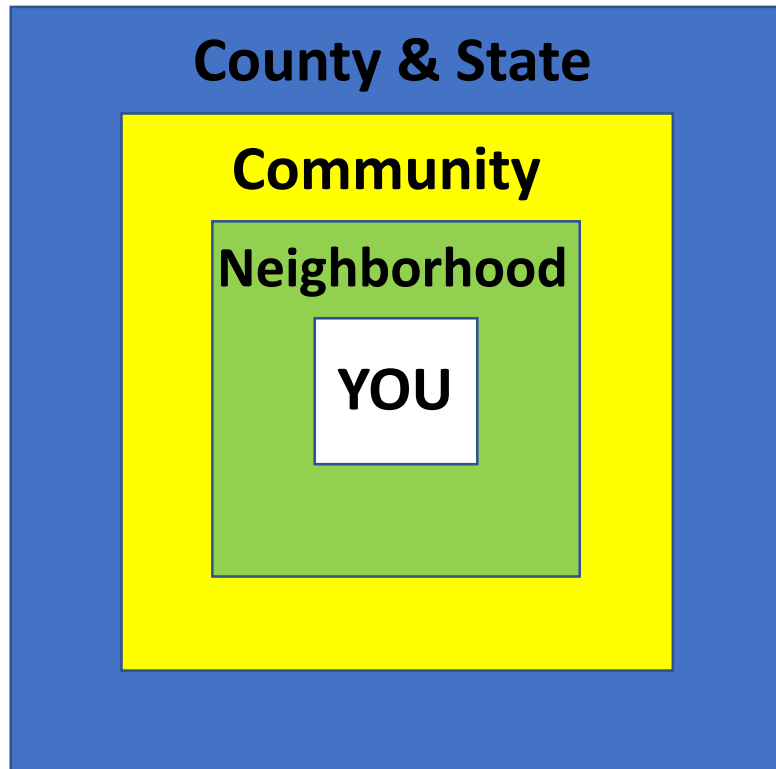
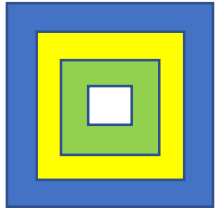


Security & Preparedness Starts With You
