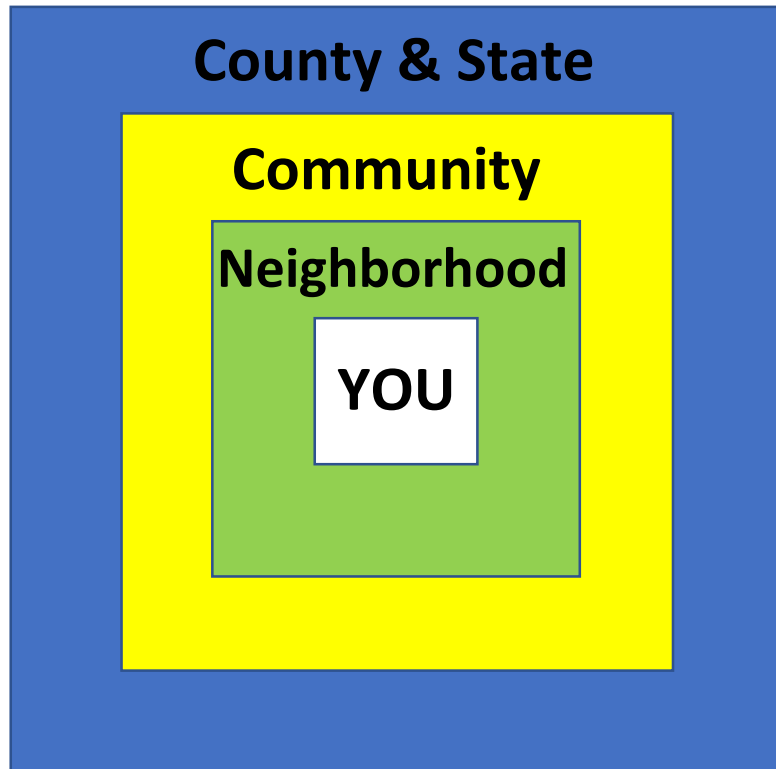


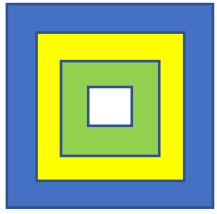

 - Know what to expect from these agencies in an emergency



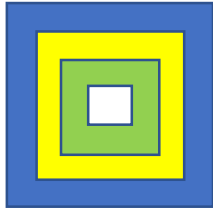
Trilogy Security and Preparedness Committee (TSPC)

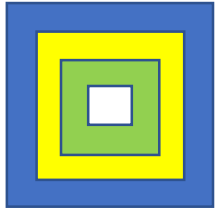
